# **Quick Start Guide**

This card is intended to familiarize the user with some of the basic ORION functions and capabilities. Minimal explanation is provided. Detailed explanations of ORION functions and procedures are provided in the User's Manual.



- POWER Press & hold: Power on/off, Quick Press: Transmit Power Mode (Auto or Manual).
- 2. **AUDIO** Press & hold: Mute/Unmute, Quick Press: Audio Alerts
- 3. TRANSMIT POWER INCREASE / UP ARROW
- 1. TRANSMIT POWER DECREASE / DOWN ARROW
- 5. VOLUME DOWN / LEFT ARROW
- 6. VOLUME UP / RIGHT ARROW
- SET Used to set the currently active menu item, Press & hold: toggles the flashlight
- 8. MENU

## To Test with 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Harmonic Test Tag:

- Press POWER to power on unit.
- Repeatedly press UP ARROW to increase transmit power to 100%
- 3. Press POWER again and select Manual Transmit Mode.
- Hold the ORION head just above the provided 2<sup>nd</sup> Harmonic Test Tag. The LED inside the enclosed test tag will light verifying that the ORION is transmitting. Notice the bar graphs are maxed out.
- 5. Press **POWER** again and select Auto Transmit Mode.
- **6.** Hold the ORION head just above the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Harmonic Test Tag. After settling, the bargraphs and display will indicate either a "semiconductor" or "corrosive" junction.

#### **Using the Audio Alerts:**

- 1. Press **VOLUME UP** to increase the volume.
- 2. Press **AUDIO** once to bring up the Audio Alerts Sub-Menu.
- 3. Select "TONE" from the Audio Alert Sub-Menu. Press SET.
- 4. Slowly sweep the ORION head across the 2<sup>nd</sup> Harmonic Test Tag. As the ORION nears the test tag, a synthetic tone will be heard indicating a strong 2<sup>nd</sup> harmonic response. As it moves closer to the test tag, the frequency of the tone will increase indicating its close proximity to the target.

Note: The trip set, or level of the 2<sup>nd</sup> harmonic signal at which the tone begins sounding, can be adjusted in the menu (See the User's Manual for details).
